Face Masks FAQs

Dear Parents,

This document is to help clarify HCS's stance on the mandatory masks as issued by Governor Holcomb Executive Order 20-37 for students in grades 3-12. Please note HCS's mask requirements could change based on IDOE, ISDH, and ACHD guidelines.

General Face Mask Information:

- 1) Face masks are define as a cloth that covers the mouth, nose, and secures to the head.
- 2) Students are to provide their own face masks for the 2020-2021 school year.
- 3) Face masks are to be of a style and design that does not violate the values and principals of HCS.
 - a. For example, face masks that have alcoholic logos would be in violation of the school's values and principals.

When to Wear Face Masks:

- 1) In any setting where a social distance of six feet cannot be maintained, masks are to be worn.
- 2) When in close proximity of others or as directed by HCS staff, students are to wear masks.

When not to Wear Face Masks:

- 1) Students will not need to wear masks when eating or drinking.
- 2) Students will not need to wear the masks when participating in gym and recess.
- 3) Students will not need to wear the masks in extra-curricular activities that involved strenuous activities.
- 4) Students who have health conditions that are covered as an exemption.
- 5) Students that can maintain a social distance of six feet while in the classroom.
